Conservation Projects funded for 2021

Dr. Jyotsna Sharma (Texas Tech Univ) – US orchid habitat restoration, propagation and reintroduction of two distinctly isolated populations of *Platanthera chapmanii* in Florida and Texas (second year funding for \$1,420.00)

Jean M. Hervouet - Protection of the Ambodiriana forest and its orchids in Madagascar (second year funding for \$1,905.00)





Cynorkis lowiana and Cynorkis schlecteri are two of the beautiful and unusual species recorded in the Ambodiriana forest in northeastern Madagascar. The conservation of these Malagasy orchid species and forest protection is being supported in part by a two year grant from the American Orchid Society. A detailed article appeared in the June 2021 edition of *Orchids*.

Dr. Ramon de Bedout Herrera (Nature Reserve La Nube, Colombia) - for orchid reproduction and reintroduction of three endangered species of Andean orchids (first year funding for \$3,961.00)



Nature Reserve La Nube, Colombia, is engaged in a long term orchid conservation project for reproduction and reintroduction of three endangered Andean species of orchids (*Masdevallia caudata, Masdevallia ludibundella*, and *Oncidium (Odm) gloriosum*).

Normandie González-Orellana (University of Puerto Rico) - *in situ* study of the Puerto Rican endemic orchid *Psychilis kraenzlinii* (first year funding for \$2,281.50)
