Description: beginning with number of flowers, buds and inflorescence
(PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY) Approximately 1100 strongly reflexed stellate flowers on ascending terminal inflorescence and no buds
up to 28cm; plant 4cm wide by 2cm tall in 6cm phatic pot grown in bark; flattened condical pseudobulbs up to 6.5cm by 2cm wide sessitose, narrow recurved chartreuse sepals and petals; non-ecapitate lip basally chartreuse apically orange sharply recurved at midlobe folded under towards base of lip; column chartreuse; bract chartreuse peduncle ninety degrees to rachis; commend for floriferousness; origin Thailand.
