Description: beginning with the number of flowers and buds and inflorescence

Plant 30 cm wide by 12 cm tall consisting of a central fan and two basal keikis; slightly keeled, curved leaves 21.6 cm long by 1.1 cm wide; approximately 525 vibrant orange flowers and 44 buds on 15 rigidly upright inflorescences; anther cap dark brown, characteristic of bird-pollination; substance medium; texture slightly crystalline; recognized as an authentic example of a rarely seen Vanda species confined to Java and likely localized areas of Sumatra and peninsular Malaysia whose nomenclature has been historically confused with V. garayi and aurantiaca, both more widespread, common species.
