plant w/ pseudobulb measuring 8.5 cm long, ovate leaves
measuring 6.5 cm wide by 18 cm long; dorsal chartreuse
dorsal, narrow spots developing a 3D vein pattern; lateral
sepals chartreuse, heavy maroon spotting; petals
chartreuse very heavy spotting, pointed tips; hinged
lip, orange, spotted maroon, button yellow anther
cap; substance waxy; texture mottled, unpleasant
