Description: beginning with number of flowers, buds and inflorescence

Approximately 625 mildly fragrant flowers and ten buds, arranged in a whorled pattern on 21 erect inflorescences up to 12cm; plant 50cm wide by 70cm tall, grown on a 22cm by 85cm cork slab; stems stoloniferous; pseudobulbs unifoliate, depressed, elongated ovate, 5cm long by 2.2cm wide, separated by rhizomes up to 13cm; leaves leathery, broadly ovate, 4.8cm wide by 12.5cm long, margins entire; flowers cupped, cream colored; dorsal sepal hooded, thinly lanceolate, lateral sepals perfect; petals short, thinly lanceolate; lip minute, hinged, pointed, yellow apically and basally, brown markings on side margins; substance firm, texture crystalline; country of origin Sulawesi, Indonesia. Awarded as Bulbophyllum obliquum, provisional upon SITF verification.
