Two flowers and no buds nestled below the foliage on two inflorescences to 15 cm on a 50 cm wide by 21 cm high plant in a tree fern pot; leaves lanceolate to 24 cm emerging singularly from cylindrical pseudobulbs; sepals and petals chartreuse, spotted burgundy, acuminate; lateral sepals fused; hinged lip burgundy with papillae at apex; column chartreuse; anther cap yellow. Substance firm, texture satiny; awarded for rarity in culture; country of origin Brazil.
