Description: beginning with the number of flowers and buds and inflorescence

Approximately 165 flowers and 90 buds arranged in a loose whorl on 3 inflorescence with 10 immature inflorescence cascading from a robust, branching plant of roughly 70 leads, mounted on tree fern over a small pad of sphagnum, growths up to 14cm in length, flat, succulent imbricating foliage, flower minute opening from apex of inflorescence, petals and sepals orange rust maroon proximally, lip dark maroon proximally orange rust distally, column cream, substance elusive, texture matte, country of origin assumed to be Philippines, specifically Mindoro Island for which it is named, recognized for educational value and botanical charm.
